- New customer counters and queue rail with oak sections
- New customer 'engage' station
- Customer waiting area featuring Amtico flooring
- New children's area with feature Bowen oak laminate flooring extending to ceiling
- Creation of 6 carpeted customer consultation rooms
- Glazed screens and doors with frosted films highlighting local places of interest
- New lay in grid ceiling and bulk heads

The Grade II listed building was built in 1904 for J.Hepworth and Son's Tailors and is a striking example of baroque revival architecture, Yorkshire Building Society has been a tenant since the early 1990's.
